PRESIDENTS REPORT

Flood water up to 2 metres deep over much of the course left flood debris and silt deposited all throughout playing areas .

Also of major concern was the extent of damage to the Pump Station, control panel and Power switchboard located at riverside.

The support from members who assisted with clean up in the weeks following the floods was fantastic.

To all members who contributed and assisted in some way with the flood clean up, checking our assets or making the morning tea, I extend to you all my appreciation of your support.

The estimated Flood damage cost to the Club will approach \$45,000 in total with the main component being related to repair of the damaged pumps, pontoon, control panel and switchboard.

Recent good news is that the Clubs application with the Department of Rural Finance to access the State Governments \$25,000 flood relief Grant available to *Not For Profit Organisations* was successful.

A Grant application has also been lodged for \$20,000 with the Commonwealth Bank Community Flood relief Grants Program.

The condition of the course over the past few weeks following the floods is fantastic with fairway grass cover as good as I have seen it for many years .

Many compliments have been received from visitors. Congratulations to staff and all the volunteers who regularly contribute to the maintenance program.

A vacancy still exists on Committee for any member interested.
